PERMIT TYPES & STANDARDS
Type A Permit – General Standards: A type A permit may be issued for sound equipment emitting music or human speech that will be registering more than sixty (65) dB(A)s when the sound level is measured at the real property boundary of the private residence nearest the sound equipment. Sound equipment permitted under a type A permit may be used only in areas of the City zoned for nonresidential and only between the hours of nine o'clock (9:00) a.m., and twelve o'clock (12:00) a.m., from any day Sunday to Thursday and only between the hours of nine o'clock (9:00) a.m., and two o'clock (2:00) a.m., from any day Friday or Saturday.
Type B Permit – Sound Trucks: Sound trucks may be operated only under a type B permit. A type B permit may be issued for sound equipment mounted upon a motor vehicle and intended for use upon City streets, provided the sound equipment emits only music or human
speech registering not more than eighty (80) dB(A)s when the sound level is measured at a distance of one hundred feet (100) from the sound equipment. Sound equipment permitted under a type B permit may be used only in nonresidential areas from nine o'clock (9:00) a.m., to nine o'clock (9:00) p.m.
Type C Permit: Parks – General Standards: A type C permit may be used for sound equipment emitting music or human speech that will be registering more than sixty (60) dB(A)s when the sound level is measured at the real property boundary of the private residence nearest the sound equipment. Sound equipment permitted under a type C permit may be used only in public parks owned and operated by the City or public grounds owned and operated by another government body from between the hours of nine o'clock (9:00) a.m., and ten o'clock (10:00) p.m., from any day Sunday to Thursday and only between the hours of nine o'clock (9:00) a.m., and twelve o'clock (12:00) a.m., from any day Friday or Saturday, for events authorized and approved by the City or other body having jurisdiction over the park or public grounds. Type D Permit: School Grounds – General Standards type D permit may be issued for sound equipment emitting music or human speech that will be registering more than sixty (60) dB(A)s when the sound level is measured at the real property boundary of the residence nearest the sound equipment Sound equipment permitted under a type D permit may be used only on school or church grounds or in conjunction with a school sponsored or church sponsored activity between the hours of nine o'clock (9:00) a.m., and ten o'clock (10:00) p.m., from any day Sunday to Thursday and only between the hours of nine o'clock (9:00) a.m., and twelve o'clock (12:00) a.m., from any day Friday
or Saturday, for events authorized and approved by the authorities having jurisdiction of the grounds. Type E Permit – Residential Events: A type E permit may be used for sound equipment emitting music or human speech that will be registering more than sixty (60) dB(A)s when the sound level is measured at the real property boundary of the private residence nearest the sound equipment. Sound equipment permitted under a type E permit may be used only pursuant to a permitted street closing and only between the hours of nine o'clock (9:00) a.m., and ten o'clock (10:00) p.m., from any day Sunday to Thursday and only between the hours of nine o'clock (9:00) a.m., and twelve o'clock (12:00) a.m., from any day Friday or Saturday.
I understand and will abide by the rules in the noise ordinance Chapter 53. An event for which a Noise Permit either has not been
obtained or which is in violation of the maximum decibel levels will also be subject to those penalties established in City Code
Chapter 4, Municipal Infractions, not to exceed \$750 for the first offense and not to exceed \$1000 for each repeat offense.
