

Disaster Assistance

Polk and Jasper Counties have been declared state and federal disaster areas.

Polk County has now been added to the list of counties in Iowa now eligible under the FEMA Individual Assistance Program. Disaster assistance is money or direct assistance to individuals, families and businesses in an area whose property has been damaged or destroyed and whose losses are not covered by insurance. It is

meant to help with critical expenses that cannot be covered in other ways. This assistance is not intended to restore damaged property to its condition before the disaster. While some housing assistance funds are available through our Individuals and Households Program, most disaster assistance from the Federal government is in the form of loans administered by the Small Business Administration.

How to apply for assistance:

1. Call 1.800.621.3362, TTY # 1.800.462.7585 or online at <http://www.DisasterAssistance.gov>
2. FEMA representatives will be arriving later this week to set up a Disaster Recovery Center (DRC), location yet to be identified.
3. Once the DRC is open, applicants must go to location and meet with FEMA who will help them obtain assistance they qualify for.

Once an application has been completed, the applicant will receive a reference number and they must have that number when they go to the DRC. If an individual goes to the DRC prior to submitting an application, they will be directed to a phone to do so prior to receiving assistance from the FEMA representatives at the DRC.

In addition to FEMA assistance, Iowa's Department of Human Services is implementing the state Individual Assistance Program. Income guidelines for eligibility are about \$40,000 for a family of four and \$22,000 for an individual. Iowans who qualify are eligible for up to \$5,000 in grants. What to do in case of an accident

According to the National Safety Council, one in every eight drivers will be involved in a motor vehicle accident this year. That may mean you! Are you prepared? Would you know what to do and what questions to ask? Here is a list of 12 steps to remember:

1. Stop your vehicle if it is clear, safe and legal.
2. Move the vehicle out of the traveled roadway.
3. Turn off the ignitions of the cars involved.
4. Make a first aid check of all persons involved in the accident.
5. Call the police.
6. Mark the scene of the accident with flares or reflective triangles.
7. Gather the names of all the persons in the motor vehicles and people who witnessed the accident.
8. Make a quick diagram of where the vehicle occupants were seated, indicate the vehicles' direction of travel and lane. Also note the date, time and weather conditions.
9. Ask to see the other drivers license and write down the number.
10. Exchange insurance company information.
11. Get a copy of the police report of the accident from the local police station.

Saturday, November 6 – Solid Waste & Tires Only • Monday, November 8 – Appliances Only

The Fall Clean Up is now at your curb side. There is no longer a central "drop off" location. The City has contracted with two different vendors to go door-to-door to collect appliances, tires, and solid waste. Have your items at your curb the night before items will be picked up (see dates above). When setting out your items, please have two separate piles – one for solid waste and the other for appliances. This will help the vendors pick up their designated items.

"Solid Waste" means residential household items that would normally **NOT** be picked up on Wednesdays (regular collection day). The term "solid waste" shall **EXCLUDE** hazardous materials, as defined by Metro Waste Authority, and may exclude any other materials as requested by the Metro Waste Authority.

Yard waste is NO longer included in the Fall Clean Up. Yard waste can be set out for pick up every Wednesday (regular collection day) until December 1 and will resume on March 30, 2011. Yard waste must be in approved bags and each bag requires a Compost It! sticker. The stickers are \$1.10 each and are available for purchase at the City Hall.

Residential passenger and truck tires will be accepted. Each household will be allowed to deposit a maximum of five (5) scrap tires (on or off rims). The deposit of scrap tires generated by any business, farm or tractor tires, or solid tires such as lawnmowers, forklift, or golf cart tires is not allowed and will not be accepted.

There is **NO** limit on the amount of metal appliances disposed of by each household. Please **DO NOT** set out any solid waste items that are collected in the regular weekly collection. Items in your toter for pick up are not allowed and will not be accepted. Toters should not be at your curb during these pick up days. **Furniture WILL be included in the Fall Clean Up.**

APPLIANCES INCLUDED IN THE COLLECTION:

- ☞ Electronics (computers, printers, fax machines, etc.)** - **NO MONITORS OR TVs**
- ☞ Water heaters
- ☞ Exercise equipment
- ☞ Kitchen appliances (stoves, dishwashers, refrigerators, washers, dryers, etc.)
- ☞ Roof-top AC units
- ☞ Lawnmowers
- ☞ Household furnaces

****TVs are not included and will not be picked up during Fall Clean Up**

ITEMS EXCLUDED FROM COLLECTION:

- ☞ Truck loads of construction materials or building parts
- ☞ Vehicle and / or major auto parts
- ☞ Concrete and / or concrete chunks
- ☞ Asphalt shingles over 65 lbs in weight
- ☞ TVs and monitors
- ☞ Animal carcasses
- ☞ Banned substances such as lead acid, waste oil, explosive material, medical waste, drugs, poisons, highly combustible material, paint and other toxic or hazardous substances. Please contact the MWA Regional Collection Center for **FREE** disposal of these items. The telephone number is 967-5512.

The City of Bondurant reserves the right to refuse service and/or acceptance if a request is not within the intent of the program or is considered unreasonable. Any items left at your curb after the completion of the Fall Clean Up are considered unacceptable. For any additional information, please contact the Bondurant City Center at 967-2418.
