

## NOTICE TO BIDDERS

### NOTICE OF TAKING BIDS FOR THE PARKSIDE WATER MAIN EXTENSION FOR THE CITY OF BONDURANT, IOWA

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Sealed proposals will be received by the City Clerk of the City of Bondurant, Iowa, at the City Hall, 200 Second Street NE, Bondurant, Iowa, before 10:00 A.M. on the 11th day of July, 2018 for the construction of the Parkside Water Main Extension, as described in the plans and specifications therefor, now on file in the office of the City Clerk. Proposals will be opened and the amount of the bids announced in said Council Chambers by the City Administrator and Project Engineers at the time and date specified above.

The location of the work to be done and the kinds and sizes of materials proposed to be used are as follows:

#### PARKSIDE WATER MAIN EXTENSION

Construct Parkside Water Main Extension including all labor, materials and equipment necessary for approximately 4,530 linear feet of 12-inch water main installed in open cut, 300 linear feet of 12-inch water main directional drilled in place, connections to existing system, hydrants, valves, excavation, backfill, PCC trail removal and replacement, traffic control, surface restoration and miscellaneous associated work, including cleanup. The project is located along and east of Highway 65 in Bondurant, Iowa.

All work and materials are to be in accordance with the proposed plans, specifications, form of contract and estimate of cost now on file in the office of the City Clerk of Bondurant, Iowa, and by this reference made a part thereof as though fully set out and incorporated herein.

All proposals and bids in connection therewith shall be submitted to the City Clerk of said City on or before the time herein set for said hearing. All proposals shall be made on official bidding blanks furnished by the City, and any alterations in the official form of proposal will entitle the Council, at its option, to reject the proposal involved from consideration. Each proposal shall be sealed and plainly identified.

Each proposal shall be made out on a blank form furnished by the municipality and must be accompanied by bid security, as follows: a certified or cashier's check, drawn on a solvent Iowa bank or a bank chartered under the laws of the United States or a certified share draft drawn on a credit union in Iowa or chartered under the laws of the United States, in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the bid, or a bid bond executed by a corporation authorized to contract as a surety in the State of Iowa in a penal sum of ten percent (10%) of the bid.
