  - For example: contribute towards new Christmas lights or contribute towards the costumed characters during the Santa Social or Tree Lighting Ceremony grants you permission for City of Bondurant to market your sponsorship.

# PARKS, OPEN SPACE, AND TRAIL SPONSORSHIP

The City of Bondurant Parks, Open Space, and Trails system is extensive and well used. There are 14 neighborhood parks, four community parks, and seven regional/special use parks spanning more than 163 acres, 8.82 miles of trails, and 3 open-air park shelters across the community.

From Lake Petocka to Eagle Park, our system is utilized year-round with our active community that engages daily outside in Bondurant!

The City of Bondurant endorses businesses, individuals, and organizations to consider a memorial item to recognize a loved one. For example, a gift such as a park bench, picnic table, or tree in a public park would be valued by anyone passing by and would last many years. The donation would accentuate Bondurant's beautiful park systems and add meaning to a somewhat simple park amenity. In addition, the City can acknowledge your generous donation with a plaque or written acknowledgment.

Don't forget, gifts are tax-deductible. Don't hesitate to get in touch with your tax professional for more details.

#### **Commemorative Benches:**

<u>Approximate price</u>: \$1200 including freight, additional supplies for installation, and labor hours. A plaque will be at an additional cost (Approximately \$250).



#### **Commemorative Tree:**

<u>Approximate price</u>: \$680 (includes the purchase of the tree and installation expense) a plaque at an additional cost (Approximately \$250 plus podium or accessory to secure to).

The tree species would be defined by the purchaser and approved by the Bondurant Tree Board or the Bondurant Tree Board can provide a suggestion based on the location where the tree will be planted. The trees are purchased in the fall during the Citywide Annual Tree Sale and planted in the fall. Memorial celebrations can be right after installation or in the proceeding year. Must allow up to 3 weeks for a plaque purchase.



#### **Commemorative Picnic Table:**

<u>Approximate price</u>: \$1,615 plus freight, additional installation supplies, and labor hours. A plaque at an additional cost (Approximately \$250).



Please allow between 8 to 12 months for the memorial bench or picnic table to be installed. Memorial items are installed during Spring-Fall. No winter installations. City staff will submit a quote for the estimated cost, which may differ from the estimated pricing above. The location of the memorial placement will be finalized with you before sending the details to the Bondurant Parks and Recreation Board for approval. A concrete pad will need to be taken into consideration, along with how the plaque will be secured.
