NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED PLANS, SPECIFICATIONS, FORM OF CONTRACT AND ESTIMATE OF COST FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE CIVIC CAMPUS IMPROVEMENTS PHASE 1 - COURTYARD DRIVE FOR THE CITY OF BONDURANT, IOWA

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At 6:00 P.M. on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of April 2024, the City Council of the City of Bondurant, Iowa will, in said Council Chambers at City Hall, 200 Second Street NE, Bondurant, Iowa, hold a hearing and said Council proposes to adopt plans, specifications, form of contract and estimate of cost for the Civic Campus Improvements Phase 1 - Courtyard Drive project.

The description of the project is as follows:

CIVIC CAMPUS IMPROVEMENTS PHASE 1 - COURTYARD DRIVE

Construct Civic Campus Improvements Phase 1 - Courtyard Drive including all labor, materials, and equipment necessary to construct a new 8 inch PCC Pavement 31 foot B-B approximately 1,000 feet in length with approximately 1,100 lineal feet of 12 inch PVC watermain, 1,050 lineal feet of 8 inch sanitary sewer, 1,100 lineal feet of 15 to 18 inch storm sewer, intakes, storm and sanitary manholes, hydrants, valves, earthwork, surface restoration, traffic control, and miscellaneous associated work, including cleanup.

Work also includes approximately 3,500 lineal feet of 15 to 18 inch sanitary sewer, sanitary manholes, 80 lineal feet of 54" roadway culvert, 120 lineal feet of 48" entrance culverts, pavement patch, earthwork, ditch improvements, surface restoration, traffic control, and miscellaneous associated work, including cleanup along 2<sup>nd</sup> St. NE/NE 78<sup>th</sup> Ave.

Civic Campus Improvements Phase 2 adds approximately 4,800 lineal feet of new PCC pavement with associated utilities and shall be let later this summer.

At said hearing, the City Council will consider the proposed plans, specifications, form of contract and estimate of cost for the project, the same now being on file in the office of the City Clerk, reference to which is made for a more detailed and complete description of the proposed improvements, and at said time and place the said Council will also receive and consider any objections to said plans, specifications and form of contract or to the estimated cost of said improvements made by any interested party.
